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**2021 Pool Operations:** In preparation for the pool opening, the Aquatic Director, Anne Gohlke, is seeking Council input on policies. Given that we are still in phase 2, the Director recommends we operate similar to the 2020 season except for the items listed below. Staff will follow the same COVID protocol and procedures as in 2020 regarding sanitation and patron counts. All operations will be subject to changing conditions and adjustments made by pool staff to address new circumstances.

- 3 hour sessions each day instead of the 3.5 per session.
- Having some swim lesson sessions.
- Offer season passes since we did not reach 50% capacity last year. We would limit the use of the season pass to one session per day except for the last hour of the session.
- Offer aerobics and adult lap swim similar to 2020 using sign up genius again.
- Have a swim team if there are enough area pools with swim teams.
- Offer some prepared foods as well as the same prepackaged food items as last year.
