

**MAY 12, 2015 PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF EDGERTON**

Dave Thomas called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m. at Edgerton City Hall to tour the parks.

Committee members present were Bonnie Slagg, Dave Thomas, Ken Haagensen, Russ Jorstad. Greg Rierson was excused. Denise Langan and Mark Wellnitz were absent. Also present were Public Works Director Tom Hartzell and City Administrator Ramona Flanigan.

Hartzell confirmed the meeting notice was properly posted on Friday, May 8, 2015. Agendas were posted at BMO Harris Bank, Edgerton Post Office, Edgerton Public Library and City Hall.

**PARK TOUR:**

- The tour started at Racetrack Park. Items discussed were a concrete extension from the new kitchen, removing the old play structure and expanding the new play structure area, and extending the beer shelter.
- At Central Park the items discussed were constructing a driveway to the cement slab (old skate park) and installing another stealth camera for the bathrooms so they can remain open 24 hours.
- At the Fish Pond Park Kevin Slagg discussed improvements needed, a sign and concrete planter were discussed and Tom will check with Nelson Young about plastic for benches.
- At Orchard Park the committee looked at the soccer field and suggested some more benches.
- At the Dickinson Park the committee suggested moving the basketball court. Tom will get an estimate for the cement slab for the court.

Being no further business before the Committee, a Haagensen/Jorstad motion to adjourn passed. All voted in favor.
