

**MARCH 15, 2021 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES  
CITY OF EDGERTON**

Jim Burdick called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m. Committee members present were Jim Burdick, Anne Radtke (remotely), and Tim Shaw. Also present were Police Chief Robert Kowalski, City Administrator Ramona Flanigan, Mayor Chris Lund, Alder Candy Davis, and Citizen Tom Klubertanz.

**APPROVAL OF PUBLIC SAFETY MINUTES:**

**DISCUSS UPDATING ELIGIBILITY LIST FOR NEW OFFICER:**

Chief Kowalski stated that the police department currently does not have an updated eligibility list. Chief Kowalski stated that in anticipation of some officers retiring in the near future he would like to move forward with creating the list so it's available when needed. The Chief already met with the Police Commission and they approved creating a new eligibility list.

**REVIEW 2020 ANNUAL REPORT:**

Chief Kowalski stated that the department is planning National Night Out for the first Tuesday in August 2021.
