
Police Department Seeks Information on Found Dog

6th Offense OWI

On 09/07/16 at 9:20PM, Edgerton Police conducted a traffic stop on Hwy 51/S. Main St. in the City of Edgerton. The vehicle was stopped as it matched the description of a vehicle involved in a complaint the Rock County Sheriff's Office was investigating.

The driver was identified as 51 year old Stephen W. Zalec, of Cambridge, WI. Zalec was arrested by Edgerton Police on suspicion of OWI. Zalec was turned over to the Rock County Jail where he was charged with 6th offense OWI, and held on a probation violation.
