**Job Descriptions**

**Aquatics**

The aquatic season runs from late May to late August. Work will consist of mornings, afternoons, evenings, weekends, and holidays.

**Lifeguard:** **11-15 employees** **(Approx. 25 hours/week)**

**Responsibilities:** Provide for the safety of the public, assist with the care and Maintenance of the facility, and public relations.

**Qualifications:** Lifeguard Training, Community First Aid, CPR: PRO, WSI preferred.

**Beginning Wage:** \$8.50/Hour  
\$9.50/Hour with WSI  
\*Must teach minimum of 2 sessions

**Cashier:** **3-4 employees** **(Approx. 15 hours/week)**

**Responsibilities:** Operation of the bathhouse, cashier/front counter, public Relations, and maintenance and care of the facility.

**Qualifications:** Community First Aid, Adult CPR, and previous experience in cashier operation preferred.

**Beginning Wage:** \$6.00/Hour

**Concessions:** **10-12 employees** **(Approx. 15 hours/week)**

**Responsibilities:** Facility and equipment operation/maintenance, sales, and Food preparations.

**Qualifications:** Ability to work with the public and previous cashier operations preferred.

**Beginning Wage:** \$6.00/Hour

**Maintenance:** **2-3 employees** **(Approx. 20 hours/week)**

**Responsibilities:** Maintain a clean, attractive, and safe aquatic facility including the bathhouse.

**Qualifications:** Experience in custodial work and lawn care preferred. Must be able to work mornings!

**Beginning Wage:** \$6.00/ Hour
