Public Safety

2016 Review

The year 2016 ended with a total of 12,003 calls for service, which is down from 2015, 13,874. Several cases remain under investigation as Officers continue to follow-up with these incidents.

A summary of 2016:

Officers conducted 854 traffic stops.

Officers issued 354 citations which were referred to Municipal Court.

Officers issued 42 citations which were referred to Circuit Court.

The department referred 103 criminal cases to circuit Court.

Office staff processed 906 vehicle registration transactions.

Officers handled 78 traffic accidents with 1 fatality. This was a multiple vehicle accident that occurred on North Main St. The department was assisted by the WSP in determining speeds associated with this accident.

The department was involved with the Coalition with several school informational functions. Also prescription drug round-ups and training through the coalition.

The department initiated a consortium with Rock County agencies to facilitate training opportunities. This has worked well, with training being scheduled for 2017.

SIU remained active. Officers were involved in multiple investigations throughout the County, resulting in several search warrants. One Officer was involved undercover for several months which resulted in several arrests.

Officers investigated a former school staff member, Kyle Bowman, and later arrested on charges involving a juvenile.

A lengthy drug investigation led to multiple charges on Lucian Lainberger II, Carol Lainberger, and Lucian Lainberger III.



On December 8th, 2016, the Rock County Sheriff's Office SWAT team along with members of the Beloit SWAT team and the Walworth County SWAT team served a search warrant at 622 ½ Wisconsin Ave, in the City of Beloit. The search warrant was the result of the Rock County Sheriff's Office Special Investigation Unit's investigation into the sale of illegal narcotics from this residence.

During the search of the property, the suspect of the investigations identified as Jazjuan O. Steel was not present, but two other individuals were arrested for outstanding warrants unrelated to the investigation. The two individuals arrested were:





Jazjuan O. Steel

Update: On December 8th, 2016 at approximately 1550hrs, Deputies from the Special Investigations Unit were able to locate and take Jazjuan Steel into custody without incident.

Based on the investigation, Steel has been arrested for the following charges:

- 5 Counts of Delivery of Heroin
- 1 Count of Possession of Cocaine
- 1 Count of Possession of THC
- 1 Count of Disorderly Conduct While Armed
- 12 Counts of Felony Bail Jumping
- 12 Counts of Misdemeanor Bail Jumping.

Steel is currently being held at the Rock County Jail and will make his initial appearance in court on Monday December 12th at 3:00 pm.

Pursuant to the directive of the Wisconsin Supreme Court, as found in Supreme Court Rule 20:3.6, Trial Publicity, you are advised that a charge is merely an accusation and that a defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
