



City of Edgerton Halloween Trick – or Treating

With the approach of Halloween, questions have been raised regarding Trick-Or-Treating. Though the City has established October 31st from 5:00-8:00 pm, it is not an activity that is sponsored by any one organization and the city does not have the ability to grant or deny a permit for the activity. It is up to each citizen to decide whether or not to participate in Halloween activities amid COVID19 based on their assessment of the situation. The CDC provides guidelines based on COVID levels in each County. The City will publish the most current CDC data just prior to the event.

As has been customary, property owners who do not wish to participate in the event should leave their front lights off so participants know not to knock on those doors. For those who choose to trick-or-treat, please be respectful of the Halloween celebration by not approaching a door with the lights out, and honor social distancing regulations.
