DISCUSS AND CONSIDER RELOCATION OF OUTFIELD FENCE:

Joe Boss wanted to discuss moving the fence in on the JV diamond. This diamond was originally put in for men's softball and we no longer have men's leagues. The girls softball leagues use that diamond frequently. The girl's league would like to host more tournaments but are limited because of WIAA rules regarding fence locations. One option for fencing was a temporary fence that can be put up for tournaments. The fence has stayed where it is due to the tobacco days men's softball tournaments and the opportunity for bringing slowpitch softball leagues back. Mark Wellnitz suggested getting prices from vendors for temporary fencing before making a decision. This issue will be put on a future agenda.

A Port-A-Potty for fish pond has been ordered. The shelter has been set up for the Fishing Derby. The park mower has been ordered and should be here in a couple of weeks. The staff is working on the new kitchen at the new food stand at Racetrack Park.

Chairperson Wellnitz asked the committee to vote on putting the soccer field location issue back on an agenda. The committee voted 4/1 to not address this issue on a future agenda.
