- By mail. You can send payment to the Clerk of Court, Edgerton City Hall, 12 Albion St., Edgerton, WI 53534. Please include a copy of your citation if possible or at least include your name and citation number.
- Online at https://www.officialpayments.com/pc home.jsp. This link can also be found on the City of Edgerton's website under "Pay Citations Online." Please note there is a nominal fee for using this service. You will need your citation number and arresting officer number that can be found on your citation. When entering your citation number, include numbers only and do not include the letters.

Further, if you do not want to submit a plea and only need time to pay the fine you do not need to do anything (you do nothing). If you do not submit a plea or pay the fine, you will be found guilty in default and given 60 days to pay the fine as listed on your citation. You will receive notification in the mail regarding the fine amount and due date.
