## VOTING OPTIONS 2020 SPRING ELECTION & PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY

**Hello voters!** Did you know you have options for casting your ballot in the April 7, 2020 election (and every election)?

For the traditional voter, who enjoys the excitement of Election Day, the polls will be open from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm at Edgerton City Hall. Our election workers will be happy to assist you. And this year, they will be especially attentive to keeping the election facility as clean and safe as possible. Extra efforts will be taken to continually wipe down voting booths and election equipment throughout the day. For voters' convenience, hand sanitizer and tissues will also be available at each station.

Not up for an Election Day trip to City Hall? Request an absentee ballot online at myvote.wi.gov prior to April 2nd, and a ballot will be mailed to you. Voters may also email or mail a written request with a photo ID (scan or copy) to the City Clerk for a ballot. This works great for travelers; those who have a suppressed immune system; or voters who just can't make it to City Hall during working hours. Please be sure to allow for mailing time, as the ballot must be returned by Election Day.

<u>Can't make it to City Hall on Election Day?</u> Voters can also vote in-person via absentee ballot at City Hall prior to election day during regular office hours. Inperson voting ends on Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 5:00 pm, so please plan ahead.
