

**SEPTEMBER 20, 2021 COMMON COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF EDGERTON**

Mayor Christopher Lund called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Casey Langan, Candy Davis, Tim Shaw, and Jim Burdick.

Absent: Sarah Braun (excused) and Paul Davis

Others Present: City Administrator Ramona Flanigan, City Clerk/Treasurer Cindy Hegglund, Municipal Services Director Howard Moser, Police Chief Robert Kowalski, Library Director Kirsten Almo, City Attorney Bill Morgan, and a few citizens.

Hegglund confirmed the meeting agendas were properly posted on Friday, September 17, 2021 at the Post Office, Edgerton Library, City website, and City Hall.

ACCEPT THE AGENDA: A Tim Shaw/Casey Langan motion approve the agenda as printed passed, all voted in favor.

MINUTES: A Jim Burdick/Tim Shaw motion to approve the minutes from the September 7, 2021 Common Council meeting passed, all voted in favor.

COMMITTEES:

Finance Committee: A Candy Davis/Tim Shaw motion to approve the bills and payroll list in the amount of \$312,165.27 passed on a 4/0 roll call vote.

A Candy Davis/Tim Shaw motion to approve waiving the rental fee for the RTP shelter for the Yahara Community Club Annual Fall Fest on October 7th passed on a 4/0 roll call vote.

STREET CLOSING: A Candy Davis/Casey Langan motion to approve the street closing on a portion of Falk Drive/Martha St for a wedding passed on a 4/0 roll call vote.

REDISTRICTING MAP: Cindy Hegglund presented two proposed redistricting maps. The purpose of redistricting is to make sure each district has approximately the same number of people using the data from the current census.

Both alternatives move Ward 7 (Dane Co) into District 3 from District 1. Plan 1 extends District 1 across Hwy 51 to the east while Plan 2 extends District 2 across Hwy 51 to the east.

A Jim Burdick/Tim Shaw motion to submit Plan 2 redistricting map for final consideration passed on a 4/0 roll call vote.

Being no other business before the Council, a Candy Davis/Casey Langan motion to adjourn passed, all voted in favor.
