

Clean Sweep Summary - 2019

THANK YOU for your support! Contributions from cities, villages, and towns go toward the cost of hazardous waste contractor service at events. The balance is covered by competitive annual state grants and Rock County. All non-vendor labor and materials are provided in-kind. Rock County Land Conservation Department manages the grants and overall program.

Sustaining Communities 9+ years of contributions since 2010: City of Edgerton, City of Janesville, Town of Bradford, Town of Fulton, and Town of La Prairie.


Helping Communities (6 – 7 years since 2010): City of Beloit, Town of Beloit, Town of Center, Town of Harmony, Town of Janesville, Town of Rock, and Town of Turtle.

With some budget uncertainties going into 2019, the program reduced drop-offs to two sites and started charging volume-based fees for all loads. The only free service was through our Ag Clean Sweep grant from DATCP, which provided free disposal for up to 200 lbs of ag chemicals with an inventory sent in advance.

The 2019 program served 129 county residents. The average household paid \$10 per load while the same load cost the program \$110. We ended with a surplus that will help pay for hazardous waste contractor service at three sites in 2020.

Based on participant surveys, most households bring material that is less than 10 years old. The old loads still come in as homes and farms change hands.
